



INFORMATION ON THE USE OF COOKIES

This information on the use of Cookies on the tapigroup.com website is given to the user in the implementation of the Guarantor's provision of 8 May 2014 ("Identification of simplified procedures for information and acquisition of consent on the use of Cookies") for the protection of personal data in compliance with art. 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679 regarding the protection of personal data (Regulation).

The information has been prepared and updated by Tapi s.p.a., manager of the website and owner of personal data associated with it, with registered office at via Cornara Est, 2/F – 35010 Massanzago (PD). One can use the same address at any time to exercise the rights conferred by the Regulation to the user as an interested party (article 15 of the Regulation: for example, access, cancellation, update, correction, integration, etc.) as well as to request the updated list of any designated Data Processors, as set out in the privacy policy.

The user's personal data is at any rate processed by specific appointees of the owner and are not communicated nor disseminated.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text strings that a website can send, while browsing, to the device being used to browse - be it a pc, notebook, smartphone, tablet; they are usually directly stored on the browser used for navigation. During a subsequent access, the same website that transmitted them can read and register the Cookies saved on the same device in order to obtain various types of information to be used for specific purposes, as set forth below.

WHAT KINDS OF COOKIES ARE THERE?

Technical Cookies. Technical cookies, the use of which does not require the user's consent, are used only to make it possible for the user to browse the website, and allow him to use its functionalities. They are distinguished as follows:

Navigational cookies: They ensure normal browsing and use of the website (allowing, for example, purchases to be made or to authenticate in order to access reserved areas); these are usually Session Cookies, so that once the browser is closed, they are automatically deactivated.

Functional Cookies: they allow memorisation of user preferences without having to reset them during subsequent visits. For this reason, Functional Cookies are often persistent cookies, as they remain stored on the user's computer until their expiry date (or until deleted).

Analytics Cookies. Analytics cookies, aimed at collecting anonymised statistical information on the use of the website by users, are similar to technical Cookies if they are used directly by the site operator in order to gather exclusively aggregated information on the number of users and on how they visit the site thereby giving the owner a better knowledge of the users and to improve the functioning of the site itself. Prior consent by the user is not required for the installation of such Cookies insofar as they are similar to technical cookies. Otherwise, the user will be asked to consent to their installation. These Cookies are usually sent by third parties external to the website. Profiling cookies. Profiling Cookies are used to create a user profile based on the preferences and tastes expressed by him/her while browsing the internet, in order to display ads on the website that match his/her profile and that are deemed to be most interesting. As required by current legislation on privacy, the installation of such Cookies requires prior consent.

WHICH COOKIES DOES THIS SITE USE?

This site uses necessary technical cookies, without which it could not function properly, and Analytics Cookies for statistical purposes; the latter, which have been supplied by external third parties, are only activated with prior explicit consent by the user. If the user does not express any consent, the site will only retain the necessary cookies, as prescribed by law. To modify the consent previously given, please refer to the specific information set out below. Google Analytics. This website uses the Google Analytics services provided by Google Ireland Limited, with anonymised IP, for statistical monitoring of the activities performed on the website. Google Analytics uses Cookies that do not store personal data. DELETING OR DEACTIVATING COOKIES

With the exception of technical Cookies necessary for navigation, the provision of data and the use of third-party services (which involves the installation of Cookies) takes place at the express will of the User, decided after having read the brief information contained in the appropriate banner. The User can avoid the installation of Cookies by keeping the banner active or by managing the preferences relating to Cookies directly within his browser. It is important that the User be aware that if he decides to disable all Cookies, the functioning of the website may be compromised.
